

SAVE THE EARTH: GROUP CHALLENGE PODCAST PROJECT

Driving Question:

- How can you create a podcast that inspires an audience to minimize their impact on the Earth?

Overview:

- Each group will select a one-week challenge to minimize their impact on the Earth.
- The challenge is documented on a podcast, which is designed to inspire others to attempt it as well in order to minimize their impact on the Earth.

Deliverables:

- You will receive an **INDIVIDUAL Habits of Mind** grade based on your role's 3 deliverables.
 - Mr. White will check your group's Google Drive folder after school on the day the deliverable is due; the work **MUST** be in the correct location for you to receive credit!
 - Rubric:
 - Score of 4:
 - All 3 deliverables are on time, complete, and high quality
 - Score of 3:
 - All 3 deliverables are on time and complete
 - Score of 2:
 - Only 2 deliverables are on time and complete
 - Score of 1:
 - Only 1 deliverable (or less) is on time and complete
- You will receive a **GROUP Communication** grade for the final podcast
 - If you receive less than a 2 for your Habits of Mind grade, you will receive a zero for this grade
 - If you do not earn at least a 2 on your individual work, that means you did not contribute enough to justify receiving the group podcast grade, or your group members had to do your deliverables for you in order to stay on track with their deadlines

NOTE: Remember that because this is a group project, your work affects every other person in your group

- If you are **absent**, it is still your responsibility to complete your deliverables
 - You need to get the phone number of every person in your group (or your group text), so it is your responsibility to communicate with your group if you are not going to be there
 - That will allow your group to make a plan for how to keep working so they don't fall behind
 - If you are absent on a deliverable due date, I will check it the next day you are at school
